

# DAILY HOME SCREENING FOR BELLEVUE STUDENTS

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please complete this screening each morning and report any absences or needs to stay home to your child(ren)'s school.

## SECTION 1: Does your child have any of the following symptoms?

- Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- Sore throat with inflammation (red and swollen, difficulty swallowing)
- **New** uncontrolled cough (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Difficulty breathing and/or shortness of breath
- Diarrhea and/or vomiting

## SECTION 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure:

- Close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19
- Traveled to an area where the local, Tribal, territorial, or state health department is reporting large numbers of COVID-19 cases
- Live in areas of high community transmission while school is open

IF YOU ANSWERED:

**YES to Section 1 but NO to Section 2:** Student should stay home from school and be evaluated by their doctor, who may encourage testing. An alternate diagnosis will allow student back to school once symptoms have improved in accordance with the school illness policy (symptom free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medications). If Covid testing is not performed and an alternate diagnosis is not given, student may return to school once **ALL** of the following return criteria has been met:

### RETURN CRITERIA

1. It has been at least 10 days since symptoms started.
2. Symptoms are improving.
3. Student has been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.

**YES to Section 1 and YES to Section 2:** Student should stay home from school and be evaluated by their doctor who may encourage testing. An alternate diagnosis will allow student back to school once symptoms have improved in accordance with school illness policy. (must be symptom free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medications). If Covid testing is not performed and an alternate diagnosis is not given, student may return to school once **ALL** of the above return criteria has been met.

**YES to Section 1 and YES to Section 2 with a Diagnosis of Covid-19:** Student may return to school once **ALL** of the above return criteria has been met.

**NO to Section 1 and YES to Section 2:** Student should self-quarantine for 14 days after their last exposure to the positive case. If symptoms develop during this time, student may return to school once **ALL** of the above return criteria has been met.

**Positive Covid-19 testing results must be reported to the school within 24 hours.** Your medical provider should provide a form with negative test results and alternate diagnosis to turn in to the nurse once your child returns to school.
